What we do:

- We run a Bass tournament that benefit's the St. Joseph's Center. All proceeds from this tournament goes to St. Joseph's Center and will be used to provide individuals and families who have special needs the opportunity to develop their abilities and potential to the fullest extent possible.
- We promote take a kid fishing and make a difference in the future.
- I go to local school and talk to the children about boat safety, bass fishing, catch and release, conservation and try to get kids involved in fishing.

 - ✓ It teaches them to respect the outdoors. (Why we catch and release, pick up garbage, how to handle fish that we are going to release, etc.)

 - ✓ It puts a smile on the children faces and for a short time they forget why they are in the hospital.
 - ✓ Gives the children some thing to look forward to.
 - ✓ The rods and reels encourage the families to spend quality, outdoor time with their children or others by taking them fishing.
- We help the Jakes club out by teaching children about fishing and casting.
- I make it appoint to take people fishing every year that have never fished before.
- We are organizing/help run a high school bass club at the Hanover Area High School
 - ✓ We meet with the club weekly/bi-weekly and the agenda ranges from boat safety, fishing techniques, equipment, patterns, or what ever our on their minds.
 - ✓ We work with the biology teachers on field trips and in the classrooms with water quality, insect and bug classification, water pollution, and ect.
- We are going to do work with special needs children and take them fishing.
- We talk and do seminars with the boy scouts and other organizations.
- We help different organizations out with their causes.
